If you have time for a **side-trip**, Three Oaks, MI (a 45-minute drive one way from South Bend) has some mighty fine grub, an old-timey movie house (Vickers Theatre), and a whiskey distillery with tours (Journeyman Distillery). Push a few miles north, and Greenbush Brewery in Sawyer has tasty brews and grub. Push a little further west, and you'll hit lovely Lake Michigan.

RELIGIOUS SERVICES
